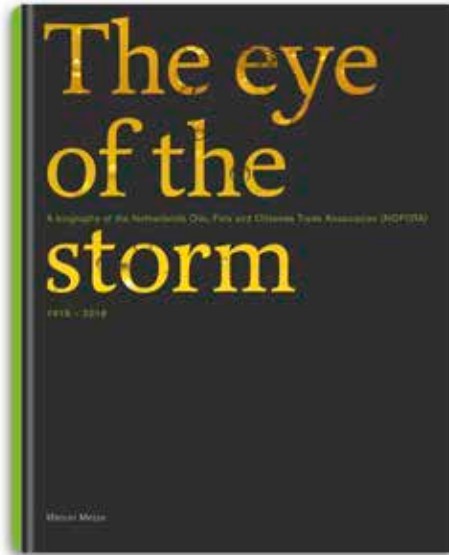

PREFACE

2018 was a remarkable year. NOFOTA celebrated her centennial!

The Netherlands Oils, Fats and Oilseeds Trade Association was established in Rotterdam on the 1st of October 1918 as *'de Nederlandsche Bond voor den Handel in Vetten, Oliën en Oliezaden*. On the 8th of January 1919 Her Majesty the Queen of the Netherlands approved the by-laws of the association, that were issued by the first board of NOFOTA, consisting of Messrs. Soberski, Timmermans, Philip, Spierenburg and Meibergen.

In 1939 the name was changed to the *'Nederlandsche Bond van Belanghebbers bij de Handel in Oliën, Vetten en Oliezaden'* and the last name change was done on 6 January 1977 to the international name *The Netherlands Oils, Fats and Oilseeds Trade Association*, as it still named today.

During the centennial dinner event on the 12th of April 2018 at the Doelen in Rotterdam special reference was made to various important moments of 100 years trade in oils and fats, oilseeds, meat and groundnuts. It was a pleasure to welcome so many members and their guests as well as the past-presidents of NOFOTA.

NOFOTA's President, Mr. van der Graaf, started in his speech as follows...

Well we're almost there: a century of NOFOTA. That is an achievement! When did it start? NOFOTA was established on the 1st of October 1918, with 4 members, after one year we had 15 members, today we have 146 members. The first council meeting was being held in April 1920. In 1925 the first collection of contracts under what we consider now as the 1st NOFOTA Trading Rules was being used. It has been a remarkable journey throughout the years. I will not spend too much time on this topic because we want to share our history with you through the eyes of Dr. Marcel Metze who has written a biography about the history of our association.

On the 18th of October 2018 NOFOTA remembered her 100th anniversary by organising a seminar on trading rules and a reception in the Hulstkamp building. The President memorized the highlights of the association which are also written down in the associations biography "The eye of the storm".

The Golf Tournament was held this year on the 4th of June at golf course Burggolf Westerpark in Zoetermeer. 26 players competed for the trophy and about 12 future golfers practised in the clinic and all together enjoyed the dinner.

1. In case the Council consists of 10 members the following categories should preferably be represented:

2. Kindred Associations, being an A-member, may appoint their President to the Council, after obtaining prior approval of the Council.
3. Members of the Council must resign after a period of 8 years and may only be re-elected after a period of 2 years. For members of the Executive Council, the election period terminates after a full service.
4. Preferably, the President will be elected for a period of 2 years alternating from the list of industrial members and other categories with the exception of those mentioned under 2.
5. Preferably, the Vice-President will be elected for 2 years and directly succeed the President for the subsequent 2 years.
6. The outgoing President will preferably be nominated as 3rd member of the Executive Council for 2 years.
7. Council members who, for any reason, resign during their appointment, may propose a successor from the same category. The elected successor starts a new 2 years election period with a maximum of 8 years.

GUIDELINES FOR QUALIFICATION AS (APPEAL) ARBITRATOR

1. Being active in the trade/industry.
2. Being minimum 30 years of age.
3. Having at least 8 years of experience in a qualified position.
4. Being a member or being employed by a member, or having been appointed by an A-member, or having been coopted by the Council.
5. Retirement as arbitrator 3 years after retirement from the trade/industry.
6. After having been arbitrator in 3 arbitrations, an arbitrator can become an appeal arbitrator too.
7. Prospective arbitrators will first follow at least 1 arbitration as an observer.

CRITERIA FOR A NOFOTA RECOGNIZED TANKSTORAGE COMPANY PER 1 JANUARY 2019

Independence

1. The storage company shall not be engaged in any way in the trade of products typical the domain of NOFOTA and guarantees to operate fully independently from any other company in executing its activities under the NOFOTA Trading Rules.

In case of one or more sister companies with other activities in the domain of NOFOTA (e.g. superintendents), these companies shall operate fully independently from the storage activities.

General conditions/insurance/certification

2. The tank storage company's approved releases shall be those reproduced in the NOFOTA Trading Rules, latest edition.
3. All activities of the tank storage company shall be subject to its general conditions valid on the date of the activity and deposited either with the relevant District Court or with the relevant Chamber of Commerce.
4. The tank storage company shall cover its liability insurance with first class underwriters as appropriate to the services performed.
5. The tank storage company shall be certified for its operations in accordance with minimal ISO 9001 (latest version):
 - In case the tank storage company facilitates the storage of food products the company should also be ISO 22000 (latest version) or equivalent certified.
 - In case the tank installation facilitates the storage of feed products the company should also be GMP+ International (or equivalent) certified.
 - In case the tank installation stores only non-food/non-feed products (technical oils & fats products) the company should at least have ISO 9001 (latest version) certification.

This implies that the tank storage company shall operate with fully qualified staff and/or contractors at the highest standard customary in the country of operation and provide structural training facilities to its staff members for continuous improvement of its level of service and operations.
6. In case the tank storage company facilitates the storage of food and/or feed products all materials and equipment (tanks, lines, pipes, pumps and valves, including sampling apparatus etc.) shall be suitable for the safe storage and handling of the product in accordance with the

“Hygienecode voor op- en overslag van eetbare oliën en vetten” (Hygiene code for storage and handling of edible oils and fats), latest version VOTOB, or equivalent for those installations outside The Netherlands, applicable on the date of the activity.

Administration

7. The tank storage company shall be equipped to render the contractual administrative assistance to the trade as provided in the current edition of the NOFOTA Trading Rules. This includes the availability of an administrative batch tracking and tracing system enabling its principals and cargo-owners/-receivers to retrieve the full history of their cargoes from the moment these were brought under the custody of the tank storage company.
8. The tank storage company shall have facilities to allow for administrative work in connection with requirements from fiscal authorities, including financial security with those authorities.

Operational/technical

9. In case of storage of food products the previous cargoes in the tanks, lines and pump systems used for storage and handling of the oils at the tank storage company must have been a product in accordance with the E.U. Commission Regulation 579/2014 or any successive Directive in force at the time of the actual storage of the goods.
All materials and equipment (tanks, lines, pipes, pumps and valves, including sampling apparatus etc.) used for storage and handling of other products shall be completely separated.
10. The tank storage company shall have available officially gauged/calibrated facilities for establishing quantity and shall offer adequate sampling facilities.

Application/duration/extension

11. A storage company applying for and operating under NOFOTA recognition shall be a member of the Association.
12. Initial NOFOTA recognition shall be subject to an audit by auditors to be appointed by the NOFOTA Technical Committee and will be granted upon proposal of the Technical Committee by the NOFOTA Council for a 3 year period.
13. After recognition is granted the storage company will be requested every three years to fill in a questionnaire and deliver it together with their latest ISO certificate and audit report to the NOFOTA Secretariat.

14. If a physical audit is deemed to be necessary, the Technical Committee of NOFOTA will inform the company with a date of such audit.
15. If a storage company does not comply with the aforementioned criteria, based on a physical or administrative audit and has received two warnings, NOFOTA holds the right to withdraw their recognition.
16. The recognition may be withdrawn at any time by the NOFOTA Council at its discretion. The recognition remains in place for all parcels stored prior to the date of withdrawal. Parcels stored after the withdrawal has been published to the members are no longer subject to recognition.

Liability

17. Any liability of NOFOTA for or resulting from the (non-) recognition of a tank storage company is excluded.

2. All activities of the laboratory shall be subject to its general conditions valid on the date of the activity and deposited either with the relevant District Court or with the relevant Chamber of Commerce.
3. The laboratory shall cover its liability Insurance with first class underwriters as appropriate to the services performed.

Operational/technical

4. The laboratory shall be accredited in accordance with the latest version of ISO 17025. The laboratory shall operate professionally in executing its activities within the trade of products typical the domain of NOFOTA. Analyses for which instructions have been given by a client shall be made by the laboratory instructed. Subject to the Principal's agreement subcontracting of standard analysis shall only be allowed to another NOFOTA recognized laboratory.
5. The laboratory shall have relevant knowledge of the NOFOTA Trading Rules as well as of relevant local and international law and regulations.
6. Methods of analyses shall be documented and valid. If analyses are done in connection with the NOFOTA Trading Rules or any contract incorporating NOFOTA Arbitration, the laboratories shall use the NOFOTA Standards of Analyses. If no NOFOTA Standard of Analyses is available, the laboratory at least shall demonstrate that the method of analysis is suitable to determine the desired analyses or properties in a reliable and accurate way, by means of method validation.
7. Reporting of the analysis results to the client shall be done in writing (by means of an original certificate of the laboratory with an authorized signature) within a reasonable time.
