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PREFACE THE BEAT GOES ON

And so another year has passed and we have already come a long way in season 23/24.

Looking back, a lot has happened since last year. The ghost of inflation seems to have almost disappeared. Energy prices have fallen significantly after record levels for natural gas and electricity. As an energy intensive sector, this was a welcome relief. Raw material prices also showed an unprecedented decline compared to previous record levels, with all the consequences that entailed.

Can it be said that there is now time to catch our breath? Personally, not in my opinion. Unrest and tension is almost palpable. A lot is going on currently from all kinds of perspectives. Economically, the recovery is still ongoing, but several regions are still struggling to get back on track. Geopolitically, the world seems more tense than ever before in the last 75 years. The war in Ukraine is still going on and the prospects are not rosy. War has also broken out in the Middle East. It seems only a matter of time before a long-running conflict in Asia will escalate as well.

Different trade flows are also developing and new routes are literally emerging, along which raw materials find their way.

Sector-wide, the consequences of Covid and the outbreak of the Ukrainian war were immediately noticeable. Just like the current situation around the Red Sea. It is admirable to see how this is being dealt with at a sectoral level and the kind of solutions that are being sought. We may need that more than ever in the coming decade.

The consequences of new EU legislations are now becoming clear and have far-reaching consequences. Not only for farmers, for entire production chains, including our own sector. We are already seeing an entire supply chain change for palm oil to Europe because otherwise EU law cannot be met. Resulting in a temporary loss of an active CIF Rotterdam futures market.

Also in the coming 24 months, a significant scale-up in biofuel production capacity will occur in Europe. This is already noticeable in the animal fats markets and in the available refining capacity for rapeseed oil. While currently the import flow of UCOs appears to be shifting from initially Europe to America. It will be interesting to see how EU's ambitions in the fields of

climate objectives, food safety and regulations will relate to economic development, prosperity and global competitiveness of the continent. Especially, for the Netherlands as a global trading country.

After three years as chair of Nofota, I am handing over the presidency this year to Lucas Dorrestein. I am confident that NOFOTA is in good hands with him. Together with other council members, he will be ready for the sectoral developments that are heading onwards to us.

For me personally, it has been three beautiful and intense years that were not always easy. But I am proud of what we have achieved as a Council. And by this way, I want to thank the members for their confidence in me.

- 2. Kindred Associations, being an A-member, may appoint their President to the Council, after obtaining prior approval of the Council.
- 3. Members of the Council must resign after a period of 8 years and may only be re-elected after a period of 2 years. For members of the Executive Council, the election period terminates after a full service.
- 4. Preferably, the President will be elected for a period of 2 years alternating from the list of industrial members and other categories with the exception of those mentioned under 2.

- 5. Preferably, the Vice-President will be elected for 2 years and directly succeed the President for the subsequent 2 years.
- 6. The outgoing President will preferably be nominated as 3rd member of the Executive Council for 2 years.
- 7. Council members who, for any reason, resign during their appointment, may propose a successor from the same category. The elected successor starts a new 2 years election period with a maximum of 8 years.

GUIDELINES FOR QUALIFICATION AS (APPEAL) ARBITRATOR

Before accepting appointment, arbitrators have the duty to satisfy themselves that they are eligible to act in the dispute and that:

- a) They are being active in the trade/industry;
- b) They are being a member or being employed by a member, or having been appointed by an A-member, or having been co-opted by the Council;
- c) They have at least 5 years of experience in a qualified position in the trade;
- d) They have not been retired from active trade for more than 5 years;
- e) They followed as an aspirant arbitrator at least 1 arbitration as an observer;
- f) They -after having been arbitrator in 3 arbitrations- can become an appeal arbitrator too;
- g) They, their company or firm, have no direct or indirect interest in the transaction in dispute;
- h) They have not already advised or been consulted by one of the parties in respect of the specific dispute;
- i) They are not suspended as an arbitrator;
- j) They have taken notice of the Code of Practice for Arbitrators.

LIST OF ARBITRAL AWARDS 2023

In the year under review 6 arbitration proceedings were applied for, of which two arbitrations were withdrawn before arbitrators started their work and one arbitration was withdrawn after the arbitrators commenced their work.

During 2023, 1 arbitral award was issued. It concerned crude degummed rapeseed oil. 2 arbitrations proceed to 2024 for finalisation of which one concerns crude sunflowerseed oil and one concerns POME.

CRITERIA FOR A NOFOTA RECOGNISED TANKSTORAGE COMPANY PER 1 JANUARY 2024

Independence

 The storage company shall not be engaged in any way in the trade of products typical the domain of NOFOTA and guarantees to operate fully independently from any other company in executing its activities under the NOFOTA Trading Rules. In case of one or more sister companies with other activities in the domain of NOFOTA (e.g. superintendence), these companies shall operate fully independently from the storage activities.

General conditions/insurance/certification

- 2. The tank storage company's approved releases shall be those reproduced in the NOFOTA Trading Rules, latest edition.
- 3. All activities of the tank storage company shall be subject to its general conditions valid on the date of the activity and deposited either with the relevant District Court or with the relevant Chamber of Commerce.
- 4. The tank storage company shall cover its liability insurance with first class underwriters as appropriate to the services performed. It must be clear from the liability insurance policy that the recognised company is covered. In case the recognised company falls under a consolidated policy it should be clear from the insurance policy that the recognised company is covered, and that mutual intercompany liability is not ruled out.
- 5. The tank storage company shall be certified for its operations in accordance with minimal ISO 9001 (latest version):
 - In case the tank storage company facilitates the storage of food products the company should also be ISO 22000 (latest version) or equivalent certified.
 - In case the tank installation facilitates the storage of feed products the company should also be GMP+ International (or equivalent) certified.
 - In case the tank installation stores only non-food/non-feed products (technical oils & fats products) the company should at least have ISO 9001 (latest version) certification.

This implies that the tank storage company shall operate with fully qualified staff and/or contractors at the highest standard customary in the country of operation and provide structural training facilities to its staff members for continuous improvement of its level of service and operations.

Administration

- 6. The tank storage company shall be equipped to render the contractual administrative assistance to the trade as provided in the current edition of the NOFOTA Trading Rules. This includes the availability of an administrative batch tracking and tracing system enabling its principals and cargo-owners/-receivers to retrieve the full history of their cargoes from the moment these were brought under the custody of the tank storage company.
- 7. The tank storage company shall have facilities to allow for administrative work in connection with requirements from fiscal authorities, including financial security with those authorities.

Operational/technical

- 8. In case of storage of food products the previous cargoes in the tanks, lines and pump systems used for storage and handling of the oils at the tank storage company must have been a product in accordance with the E.U. Commission Regulation 579/2014 or any successive Directive in force at the time of the actual storage of the goods. All materials and equipment (tanks, lines, pipes, pumps and valves, including sampling apparatus etc.) used for storage and handling of other products shall be completely separated.
- The tank storage company shall have available officially gauged/ calibrated facilities for establishing quantity and shall offer adequate sampling facilities.

Application/duration/extension

- 10. A storage company applying for and operating under NOFOTA recognition shall be a member of the Association.
- Initial NOFOTA recognition shall be subject to an audit by auditors to be appointed by the NOFOTA Technical Committee and will be granted upon proposal of the Technical Committee by the NOFOTA Council for a 3 year period.
- 12. After recognition is granted the storage company will be requested every three years to fill in a questionnaire and deliver it together with their latest ISO certificate and audit report to the NOFOTA Secretariat.
- 13. If a physical audit is deemed to be necessary, the Technical Committee of NOFOTA will inform the company with a date of such audit.

- 14. If a storage company does not comply with the aforementioned criteria, based on a physical or administrative audit and has received two warnings, NOFOTA holds the right to withdraw their recognition.
- 15. The recognition may be withdrawn at any time by the NOFOTA Council at its discretion. The recognition remains in place for all parcels stored prior to the date of withdrawal. Parcels stored after the withdrawal has been published to the members are no longer subject to recognition.

Liability

16. Any liability of NOFOTA for or resulting from the (non-) recognition of a tank storage company is excluded.

CRITERIA FOR A NOFOTA RECOGNISED LABORATORY PER 1 JANUARY 2024

Independence

 The laboratory shall not be engaged in any way in the trade of products typical the domain of NOFOTA and guarantees to operate fully independently from any other company in executing its activities under the NOFOTA Trading Rules.

In case of one or more sister companies with other activities in the domain of NOFOTA (e.g. superintendence), these companies shall operate fully independently from the laboratory activities.

General conditions/insurance

- 2. All activities of the laboratory shall be subject to its general conditions valid on the date of the activity and deposited either with the relevant District Court or with the relevant Chamber of Commerce.
- 3. The laboratory shall cover its liability insurance with first class under-writers as appropriate to the services performed. It must be clear from the liability insurance policy that the recognised company is covered. In case the recognised company falls under a consolidated policy it should be clear from the insurance policy that the recognised company is covered, and that mutual intercompany liability is not ruled out.

Operational/technical

- 4. The laboratory shall be accredited in accordance with the latest version of ISO 17025. The laboratory shall operate professionally in executing its activities within the trade of products typical the domain of NOFOTA. Analyses for which instructions have been given by a client shall be made by the laboratory instructed. Subject to the Principal's agreement subcontracting of standard analysis shall only be allowed to another NOFOTA recognised laboratory.
- 5. The laboratory shall have relevant knowledge of the NOFOTA Trading Rules as well as of relevant local and international law and regulations.
- 6. Methods of analyses shall be documented and valid. If analyses are done in connection with the NOFOTA Trading Rules or any contract incorporating NOFOTA Arbitration, the laboratories shall use the NOFOTA Standards of Analyses. If no NOFOTA Standard of Analyses is available, the laboratory at least shall demonstrate that the method of analysis is suitable to determine the desired analyses or properties in a reliable and accurate way, by means of method validation.

 Reporting of the analysis results to the client shall be done in writing (by means of an original certificate of the laboratory with an authorized signature) within a reasonable time.

Types of recognition/application/duration/extension

- 8. The NOFOTA recognition scheme for laboratories consists of a standard recognition, relating to the standard contractual analyses.
- 9. A laboratory applying for and operating under NOFOTA recognition shall be a member of the Association.
- 10. The laboratory shall participate in the yearly organized ring test. In order to judge laboratories on their correctness and reproducibility in standard and specific analyses, NOFOTA has decided to align to the yearly FOSFA Proficiency Test for the Oils and Fats section, under the condition that the results of the Proficiency Test for the NOFOTA laboratories are made available to NOFOTA. NOFOTA can decide to replace the aforementioned yearly ring test by a blind ring test or an additional ring test organized by NOFOTA.
- 11. Initial NOFOTA recognition shall be subject to an audit by auditors to be appointed by the NOFOTA Technical Committee and will be granted upon proposal of the Technical Committee by the NOFOTA Council for a 3 year period.
- 12. After recognition is granted the laboratory will be requested every three years to fill in a questionnaire and deliver it together with their list of accredited analyses and their latest ISO audit report to the NOFOTA Secretariat.
- 13. If a physical audit is deemed to be necessary, the Technical Committee of NOFOTA will inform the company with a date of such audit.
- 14. If a laboratory does not comply with the aforementioned criteria, based on a physical or administrative audit and has received two warnings, NOFOTA holds the right to withdraw their recognition.
- 15. The recognition may be withdrawn at any time by the NOFOTA Council at its discretion.

Liability

16. Any liability of NOFOTA for or resulting from the (non-) recognition of a laboratory is excluded.
